



Q11. A 11-year-old girl in a tribal district of a state died of starvation. It has been reported that she died months after her family's ration card was cancelled because it was not linked to her Aadhaar number. Also, she could not get food under Mid Day Meal as the school had 8 days holiday, during that period she barely had any food and hence the death. The local ration dealer had refused to give the girl's family their rations for the past six months, his move followed a Central government order in February making Aadhaar compulsory for accessing subsidised food grain through the Public Distribution System. Activists from the village had raised this issue of cancelled ration cards at a public hearing organised by the district collector. Following the incident, the state government constituted a fact- finding committee.


