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
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About PMMVY



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


It is a direct benefit transfer (DBT) scheme under which cash benefits are provided to pregnant women in their bank account directly to meet enhanced nutritional needs and partially compensate for wage loss.



The scheme covers all Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers, except those who are in regular employment with the Central Government or State Government or Public Sector Undertaking or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force, for **first living child in all parts of the country.**


Under the scheme, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers receive a cash benefit of **Rs. 5,000** in three installments on fulfilling the respective conditionality, viz. early registration of pregnancy, ante-natal check-up and registration of the birth of the child and completion of the first cycle of vaccination for the first living child of the family.

The eligible beneficiary also receives the remaining cash incentive as per approved norms towards maternity benefit under **Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY)** after institutional delivery so that on an average, a woman gets Rs 6,000/-.




Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana has achieved a significant milestone by crossing one crore beneficiaries.


Janani Suraksha Yojana

Janani Suraksha Yojana is a safe motherhood intervention under the **National Rural Health Mission (NRHM)** being implemented with the objective of reducing maternal and neo-natal mortality by promoting institutional delivery among the poor pregnant women.





The Yojana, launched on 12th April 2005, is being implemented in all states and UTs with special focus on low performing states.

JSY is a **100 % centrally sponsored scheme** and it integrates cash assistance with delivery and post-delivery care.
