#### **Solutions:**

#### 1. Answer: C

## Explanation

- The Election Commission of India (ECI), for the first time in a Lok Sabha Election, has provided the 'vote-from-home' (VfH) facility for the elderly and Persons with Disabilities in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. Hence, both the statements are correct.
- Now, voters above 85 years of age and PwDs with 40% benchmark disability can choose to vote from home.
- Over 81 lakh voters are aged 85 or above, and there are more than 90 lakhs registered PwD voters across the country.
- This process involves a full team of polling staff and security personnel, ensuring the secrecy
  of voting is maintained.
- The new initiative upholds the ECI's motto of ensuring No voter is left behind.

#### **Voting Process**

- Eligible voters must complete **Form 12D** (Application for postal ballot facility) within five days of the election notification and submit it to the **returning officer**. PwD voters need to include a **baseline disability certificate** with their applications.
- A dedicated team, including polling officials and security personnel, visits the voter's residence to collect their votes. The entire process is recorded for transparency.

#### Why in the News?

• The 'vote-from-home' facility of ECI has received an enthusiastic response from voters.

#### 2. Answer: C

#### **Explanation**

- Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully flight-tested the **RudraM-II air-to-surface missile** from Su-30 MK-I platform of the Indian Air Force (IAF) off the coast of Odisha.
- The flight-test met all the trial objectives, validating the propulsion system and control & guidance algorithm.

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- The performance of the missile has been validated from the flight data captured by range tracking instruments like electro-optical systems, radar and telemetry stations deployed by Integrated Test Range, Chandipur at various locations, including the on-board ship.
- RudraM-II is an indigenously-developed solid-propelled air-launched missile system
  meant for Air-to-Surface role to neutralise many types of enemy assets. Hence both the
  statements are correct.
- A number of state-of-the-art indigenous technologies developed by various DRDO laboratories have been incorporated in the missile system.

#### 3. Answer: B

#### **Explanation**

- The United Nations Peacekeeping Forces are employed by the UN to maintain or re-establish peace in an area of armed conflict.
- The UN may engage in conflicts between states as well as in struggles within states. The UN acts as an impartial third party in order to prepare the ground for a settlement of the issues that have provoked armed conflict.
- The **three basic principles** that guide U.N.'s Peacekeeping missions are:
  - Consent of the parties
  - Impartiality
  - o Non-use of force except in self-defence and defence of the mandate.
- Statement 3 is correct: The UN Peacekeeping Forces may only be employed when both parties to a conflict accept their presence.
- The Peacekeeping Forces are subordinate to the leadership of the United Nations. They are normally deployed as a consequence of a UN Security Council decision. However, on occasion, the initiative has been taken by the General Assembly. Operational control belongs to the Secretary-General and his secretariat.
- **India** has been among the largest troop-contributing countries to the U.N. peacekeeping missions.
- **Statement 2 is correct:** The first UN peacekeeping mission was a team of observers deployed to the Middle East in 1948, during the **1948 Arab–Israeli War**.
- **Statement 1** is incorrect: Peacekeeping forces are multinational. Troops are voluntarily contributed by member states, including both permanent and non-permanent members of the Security Council, as well as countries not on the Security Council at all. In fact, the majority of troops typically come from African and Asian countries.

## Why in News?

- The Indian Army commemorated the 76th International Day of UN Peacekeepers.
- India has a rich legacy of contribution to UN Peacekeepers operations and is **one of the largest contributors of troops.**
- India has contributed services of approximately 2,87,000 troops to peacekeeping missions.
- The Indian Army has established a **Centre for UN Peacekeeping (CUNPK) in New Delhi** to impart niche training in peacekeeping operations. This Centre trains more than 12,000 troops every year.

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#### 4. Answer: C

#### **Explanation**

- **Statement 1 is correct:** Founded in **1948**, the World Health Organization (WHO) is the **United Nations agency** that connects nations, partners and people to promote health, keep the world safe and serve the vulnerable so everyone, everywhere can attain the highest level of health.
- By connecting countries, people and partners, WHO strive to give everyone, everywhere an equal chance at a safe and healthy life.

## **World Health Assembly**

- **Statement 2 is correct:** The World Health Assembly is the **decision-making body of WHO**.
- It is attended by **delegations from all WHO Member States** and focuses on a specific health agenda prepared by the Executive Board.
- The main functions of the World Health Assembly are to determine the policies of the Organization, appoint the Director-General, supervise financial policies, and review and approve the proposed programme budget.
- The Health Assembly is held annually in **Geneva**, **Switzerland**.

#### Why in News?

• The 77th World Health Assembly of WHO is being held in Geneva.

#### 5. Answer: D

#### **Explanation**

#### What is a Tropical Cyclone?

- A tropical cyclone is a **rapidly rotating storm that begins over tropical oceans**, and they can vary in speed, size, and intensity.
- Tropical cyclones are also called **hurricanes or typhoons**, depending on the region.
- According to the World Meteorological Organisation (WMO), Tropical cyclones are the second-most dangerous natural hazards, after earthquakes.

#### **Conditions for the formation of Tropical Cyclone**

- **Statement 1 is correct:** A source of **warm, moist air** derived from tropical oceans with sea surface temperatures normally in the region of, or in excess, **of 27** °C;
- Winds near the ocean surface blowing from different directions **converging** and causing air to rise and storm clouds to form;
- **Statement 2 is correct:** Winds which do not vary greatly with height known as **low wind shear**. This allows the storm clouds to rise vertically to high levels;
- **Statement 3 is correct:** Sufficient distance from the equator to provide spin or twist.

#### Why in News?

• The severe cyclonic storm Remal made its landfall process between Sagar Island in West Bengal and Khepupara in Bangladesh.
