Explanation About DigiLocker

- DigiLocker is a flagship initiative of the **Ministry of Electronics & IT (MeitY)** under the **Digital India programme**.
 - Digital India is a flagship programme of the Government of India with a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.
- It is a secure cloud based platform for storage, sharing and verification of documents & certificates. Hence, statement 1 is correct.
- Linked to both **Aadhaar card and cellphone numbers**, DigiLocker **eliminates the use of physical documents** as part of the government's Digital India drive, since all data is stored in the **cloud**. Hence, **statement 3 is correct**.
- One can upload scanned copies of their documents (PDF, JPEG or PNG format) and access
 it anywhere they want. One can also e-sign these uploaded documents, which works like
 self-attestation of physical documents.
- On the other hand, organisations like the CBSE, the Registrar Office or the Income Tax Department can also push electronic copies of documents and certificates directly into Citizens' e-lockers.
- The issued documents in DigiLocker system are deemed to be at par with original physical documents as per the Information Technology (Preservation and Retention of Information by Intermediaries providing Digital Locker facilities) Rules, 2016. Hence, statement 2 is correct.
- DigiLocker is available both on websites and mobile apps.

2. Answer: A

Explanation

- Israel has a **four-layered air defence network** to tackle a range of projectiles, short-range mortars, rockets and long-range ballistic missiles. Hence, **answer is option A**.
- These comprise the **Iron Dome (short range)**, **David's Sling (low to mid-range)**, **Arrow II (upper-atmospheric)**, and **Arrow III (exo-atmospheric)**.

About Iron Dome

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- Iron Dome is a short-range anti-rocket, anti-mortar, and anti-artillery system with an intercept range of 2.5 to 43 miles and was developed by Rafael Advanced Defence Systems of Israel.
- Israel has at least 10 Iron Dome batteries deployed throughout the country, each designed to defend a 60-square-mile populated area and can be moved as threats change.
- Iron Dome's targeting system and radar first track the trajectory of incoming projectiles and are designed to fire its **Tamir interceptors** only at those which are likely to land in populated areas or important areas/targets.
- In the past, Israel has put Iron Dome's interception rate at as high as 97%.

3. Answer: B

Explanation

About Air Quality Index (AQI)

- AQI is a number, which is a measure of air quality. The higher the AQI, the worse the air. Hence, statement 1 is incorrect.
- The colour-coded AQI index was launched by the Government of India in 2014, and it
 helps the public and the government understand the condition of the air and what
 subsequent measures are to be taken to combat the situation, based on its severity. Hence,
 statement 2 is correct.

AQI Category Associated Health Impact

Good (0 to 50)	Minimal impact
Satisfactory (51 to 100)	May cause minor breathing discomfort to sensitive people
Moderately Polluted (101 to 200)	May cause breathing discomfort to the people with lung disease such as asthma and discomfort to people with heart disease, children and older adults
Poor (201 to 300)	May cause breathing discomfort to people on prolonged exposure and discomfort to people with heart disease
Very Poor (301 to 400)	May cause respiratory illness to the people on prolonged exposure. Effect may be more pronounced in people with lung and heart diseases
Severe (401 to 500)	May cause respiratory effects even on healthy people and serious health impacts on people with lung/heart diseases. The health impacts may be experienced even during light physical activity

There are six categories of AQI, namely 'Good' (0-50), 'Satisfactory' (51-100), 'Moderately polluted' (101-200), 'Poor' (201-300), 'Very Poor' (301-400), and 'Severe' (401-500).

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4. Answer: B

Explanation About NATO

- Formed in **1949** with the signing of the **Washington Treaty**, NATO is a **security alliance of 31 countries from North America and Europe**. Hence, **statement 1 is incorrect**.
- Established in the Cold War as a bulwark against Soviet aggression, NATO's fundamental goal is to safeguard the freedom and security of all its members by political and military means.
- **Article 5 of the Washington Treaty** states that an attack against one Ally is an attack against all is at the core of the Alliance, a promise of **collective defence**. Hence, **statement 2 is correct.**
 - Article 5 has been invoked only once in NATO history. It happened after the September 11 attacks on the United States in 2001, which led the alliance into Afghanistan.
- A "NATO decision" is the expression of the collective will of all 31 member countries since all decisions are taken by consensus. Hence, statement 3 is correct.
- NATO is funded by Allies both directly and indirectly. Direct contributions are made to NATO budgets and programmes on an agreed cost-share formula, based on Gross National Income. Indirect funding is where allies commit capabilities or troops to a military operation.
- At present, NATO has 32 members. In 1949, there were 12 founding members of the Alliance: Belgium, Canada, Denmark, France, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, the United Kingdom and the United States.
- The other member countries are: Greece and Turkey (1952), Germany (1955), Spain (1982), the Czech Republic, Hungary and Poland (1999), Bulgaria, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia (2004), Albania and Croatia (2009), Montenegro (2017) North Macedonia (2020), Finland (2023) and Sweden (2024).
- NATO's Headquarters are located in **Brussels**, **Belgium**.

Why in News?

- The UK has announced support to NATO's efforts to enhance its space capabilities, including the possibility of using UK launch vehicles and spaceports.
- This initiative, known as the **STARLIFT programme**, aims to develop a network of space launch capabilities across the alliance.

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
