 The National Health Authority (NHA) has been given the mandate by the government to design, build, roll-out and implement the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission in the country.

- NHA is an attached office of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare with full functional autonomy.
- The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission was launched by the Government of India in 2020 for promoting digitization of healthcare and creating an open interoperable digital health ecosystem for the country.

#### 2. Answer: B

## **Explanation:**

- Enforcement Directorate (ED) was constituted in **1956** for **handling Exchange Control Laws violations under the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act (FERA)**.
- The ED today is a multi-disciplinary organization mandated with investigation of the offence of money laundering and violations of foreign exchange laws. Hence statement 1 is correct.
- Headquartered at New Delhi, the administrative control of the Directorate is with the Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance. Hence statement 2 is incorrect.
- The ED director is appointed as per provisions of the Central Vigilance Commission Act,
  2003. Hence statement 3 is correct.
  - The Centre appoints the director on **recommendation of a committee**, with the **Central Vigilance Commissioner as chairperson.**

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched Bima Sakhi Yojana at Panipat in Haryana to promote financial literacy and insurance awareness among women.
- This initiative of Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) will empower women aged 18 to 70 years, who are Class 10th pass, providing specialized training and a stipend for the first three years. Hence statement 3 is incorrect.
- The scheme aims to provide rural women with opportunities to become insurance agents, known as Bima Sakhis, and earn a livelihood while promoting insurance awareness in rural areas. Hence statement 1 is correct.
- The LIC Bima Sakhi Yojana is expected to not only create **new livelihood opportunities** for rural women but also help in **enhancing insurance penetration** in under-served regions of India. **Hence statement 2 is correct.**
- Through this initiative, LIC seeks to combine social welfare with business growth, empowering women while contributing to the broader goal of financial inclusion.
