

2. Answer: C Explanation:

- The Ninety Ninth Amendment Act, 2014: This act sought to replace the collegium system of appointment of Supreme Court and High Court judges by establishing a National Judicial Appointment Commission (NJAC). Hence pair 1 is incorrectly matched.
- The Hundred First Amendment Act, 2016: This act brought the GST regime in existence under the 'One Nation One Tax' slogan. Hence pair 2 is incorrectly matched.

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The Hundred Sixth Amendment Act, 2023: This has finally paved the way for 33

per cent reservation for women in both Lok Sabha and state assemblies. Hence

pair 3 is incorrectly matched.

3. Answer: B

Explanation:

• National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) is a pan-India electronic trading portal

which networks the existing Agricultural Produce Market Committee (APMC) mandis

to create a unified national market for agricultural commodities. Hence

statement 1 is correct and statement 3 is incorrect.

It provides the farmers access to nationwide market, with prices commensurate with

the quality of their produce.

• Launched in **2016**, e-NAM is **completely funded by the Central Government** and is

implemented by **Small Farmers Agribusiness Consortium (SFAC)**, under the aegis

of Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare. **Hence statement 2 is correct.**

e-NAM portal enables farmers to **trade their produce through their nearby e-NAM**

mandis and facilitate traders to bid online from any location.

• The e-NAM portal provides **single window services** for all APMC related information

and services such as commodity arrivals, quality & prices and buy & sell offers, etc.

4. Answer: A

Explanation:

Article 124: Establishment and Constitution of the Supreme Court

• (1) There shall be a Supreme Court of India consisting of a Chief Justice of India and,

until Parliament by law prescribes a larger number, of not more than 7 other Judges.

Hence statements 1 and 2 are incorrect.

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• (2) Every Judge of the Supreme Court shall be appointed by the President by warrant under his hand and seal and shall hold office until he attains the age of sixty-five years. Hence statement 3 is correct.

5. Answer: C

Explanation:

- Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) was established in 1970 under the administrative control of the Ministry of Textiles as a Public Sector Undertaking under the Companies Act 1956.
- In the initial period of setting up, as the only public sector undertaking in the field of
 marketing of cotton, CCI played a role of a canalizing agency for imports of cotton and
 purchase of raw cotton for giving necessary price support to enterprising cultivators
 and also for procuring raw cotton for textile mills.
- The role and function of CCI continued to enlarge with the changing cotton scenario in the country.
- Now, the major role of the CCI is to **undertake price support operations**, whenever the market prices of kapas fall below the minimum support prices (MSP) announced by Govt. of India, **without any quantitative limit**. **Hence statement 1 is correct.**
- Besides MSP operations, to fulfil the raw material requirement of the domestic textile industry particularly for lean season, CCI undertakes commercial purchase operations. Hence statement 2 is correct.
