## Solutions:

#### 1. Answer: B

#### **Explanation**:

- Much of India's present-day northeast was temporarily under **Burmese occupation** until the **British** pushed them out in the 1800s.
- The victors and the vanquished signed the **Treaty of Yandaboo in 1826**, leading to the current alignment of the **boundary between India and Burma**, later renamed **Myanmar**. **Hence answer is option B**.
- The border **divided people of the same ethnicity and culture** specifically the **Nagas** of Nagaland and Manipur and the **Kuki-Chin-Mizo communities** of Manipur and Mizoram without their consent.

2. Answer: C

#### **Explanation**:

- SVAMITVA (Survey of villages and mapping with improvised technology in village areas) scheme is a collaborative effort of the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, State Panchayati Raj Departments, State Revenue Departments and Survey of India. It was launched in 2021.
- It is a **central sector scheme** that aims to provide rural people with the **right to document their residential properties** so that they can use their property for economic purposes.
- The scheme is for surveying the land parcels in rural inhabited areas using Drone technology. Hence statement 1 is correct.

Objectives

• **Creation of accurate land records** for rural planning and reduce property related disputes.

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- To bring **financial stability** to the citizens in rural India by enabling them to use their property as a financial asset for taking loans and other financial benefits. **Hence statement 2 is correct.**
- **Determination of property tax,** which would accrue to the Gram Panchayats directly in States where it is devolved or else, add to the State exchequer.
- Creation of **survey infrastructure** and **GIS maps** that can be leveraged by any department for their use.
- To support in preparation of **better-quality Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP)** by making use of GIS maps. **Hence statement 3 is correct.**

#### 3. Answer: D

#### **Explanation:**

#### Most Favoured Nation Principle

- The Most Favoured Nation (MFN) principle is based on the idea that **countries should treat** all their trade partners equally—that no one country should be "more favoured."
- It means **no country should give special treatment** to goods or services coming from one particular trading partner. Although its name implies favoritism toward another nation, it denotes the equal treatment of all countries. **Hence statement 1 is incorrect**.
- The World Trade Organization (WTO) has made the most favoured nation principle part of its rules under the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) to which India is a signatory. Hence statement 2 is incorrect.
- WTO members are not allowed to favour any one country with, for example, lower tariffs on particular products without giving all members the same benefit.

#### 4. Answer: C

#### **Explanation**:

• **Disasters covered under State Disaster Response Fund:** Cyclone, Drought, Earthquake, Floods, Tsunami, Hailstorm, Landslide, Avalanche, Cloud burst, Pest attack, Frost and Cold wave. **Hence statement 1 is correct.** 

#### Local Disaster

• State Government may use up to **10% of the funds** available under SDRF for providing immediate relief to the victims of the natural disaster that day considered to be "**Disaster**" within the local contacts in the State and which is not included in the notified list of disaster of the Ministry of Home Affairs. Hence statements 2 and 3 are correct.

#### 5. Answer: B

#### **Explanation**:

• Lymphatic filariasis, commonly known as elephantiasis, is a neglected tropical disease. Hence statement 3 is correct.

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- It is a **parasitic disease** caused by microscopic, thread-like **worms**. The adult worms only live in the human lymph system. The lymph system maintains the body's fluid balance and fights infections. Hence **statement 1 is correct**.
- Lymphatic filariasis is **spread from person to person by Culex mosquitoes. Hence statement 2 is incorrect.**
- People with the disease can suffer from lymphedema and elephantiasis and in men, swelling of the scrotum, called hydrocele.
- Lymphatic filariasis is a leading cause of permanent disability worldwide.
- These patients are not only physically disabled, but suffer mental, social and financial losses contributing to stigma and poverty.
- Lymphatic filariasis can be eliminated by stopping the spread of infection through **preventive chemotherapy** with safe medicine combinations repeated annually.
