


Solutions:

1. Answer: C

Explanation

- The Karman line is a **boundary** 62 miles (100 kilometers) above mean sea level that **borders Earth's atmosphere and the beginning of space.**
- It is widely accepted as the **boundary line separating the Earth's atmosphere from outer space**.
- The line is named after Hungarian American engineer and physicist **Theodore von Karman**.

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2. Answer: B

Explanation

- Statement 1 is incorrect: Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) is an initiative of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India to deal with cyber crime in the country in a coordinated and comprehensive manner.
- Statement 2 is correct: The I4C works under the Union Home Ministry to create an effective framework and ecosystem for the prevention, detection, investigation, and prosecution of cybercrime in the country.
- I4C focuses on tackling all the issues related to Cybercrime for the citizens, which includes improving coordination between various Law Enforcement Agencies and the stakeholders, driving change in India's overall capability to tackle Cybercrime and to improve citizen satisfaction levels.

Objectives of I4C

- To act as a **nodal point to curb Cybercrime** in the country.
- To strengthen the fight against Cybercrime committed against women and children.
- Facilitate **easy filing Cybercrime related complaints** and identifying Cybercrime trends and patterns.
- To act as an early warning system for Law Enforcement Agencies for **proactive Cybercrime prevention and detection**.
- **Awareness creation** among the public about preventing Cybercrime.

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• Assist States/UTs in capacity building of Police Officers, Public Prosecutors and Judicial Officers in the area of cyber forensic, investigation, cyber hygiene, cyber-criminology, etc.

3. Answer: B

Explanation

- The United Nations Peacekeeping Forces are employed by the UN to maintain or re-establish peace in an area of armed conflict.
- The UN may engage in conflicts between states as well as in struggles within states. The UN acts as an impartial third party in order to prepare the ground for a settlement of the issues that have provoked armed conflict.
- The **three basic principles** that guide U.N.'s Peacekeeping missions are:
 - o Consent of the parties
 - o **Impartiality**
 - o Non-use of force except in self-defence and defence of the mandate.
- Statement 3 is correct: The UN Peacekeeping Forces may only be employed when both parties to a conflict accept their presence.
- The Peacekeeping Forces are subordinate to the leadership of the United Nations. They are normally deployed as a consequence of a **UN Security Council** decision. However, on occasion, the initiative has been taken by the **General Assembly**. Operational control belongs to the **Secretary-General and his secretariat**.
- **India** has been among the largest troop-contributing countries to the U.N. peacekeeping missions.
- Statement 2 is correct: The first UN peacekeeping mission was a team of observers deployed to the Middle East in 1948, during the 1948 Arab-Israeli War.
- **Statement 1 is incorrect:** Peacekeeping forces are multinational. Troops are voluntarily contributed by member states, including both permanent and non-permanent members of the Security Council, as well as countries not on the Security Council at all. In fact, the majority of troops typically come from African and Asian countries.

4. Answer: A

Explanation

The Fugitive Economic Offenders Act, 2018 (FEOA):

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- This law was enacted to deter economic offenders from evading the process of Indian law by remaining outside the jurisdiction of Indian courts. (by fleeing the country). Hence option A is correct.
- It is a law whereby the Directorate is mandated to **attach the properties of the fugitive economic offenders** who have escaped from India warranting arrest and provide for the confiscation of their properties to the Central Government.

5. Answer: D

Explanation

What is a Tropical Cyclone?

- A tropical cyclone is a **rapidly rotating storm that begins over tropical oceans**, and they can vary in speed, size, and intensity.
- Tropical cyclones are also called hurricanes or typhoons, depending on the region.
- According to the World Meteorological Organisation (WMO), Tropical cyclones are the second-most dangerous natural hazards, after earthquakes.

Conditions for the formation of Tropical Cyclone

- **Statement 1 is correct:** A source of **warm, moist air** derived from tropical oceans with sea surface temperatures normally in the region of, or in excess, **of 27** °C;
- Winds near the ocean surface blowing from different directions converging and causing air to rise and storm clouds to form;
- Statement 2 is correct: Winds which do not vary greatly with height known as low wind shear. This allows the storm clouds to rise vertically to high levels;
- Statement 3 is correct: Sufficient distance from the equator to provide spin or twist.
