1) Consider the following statements:

Statement-I: The PM SHRI Scheme aims to transform selected existing schools into model institutions aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Statement-II: Under the PM SHRI Scheme, only Kendriya Vidyalayas and Navodaya Vidyalayas are eligible for selection as PM SHRI Schools.

Which one of the following is correct in respect of the above statements?

- (a) Both Statement-I and Statement-II are correct and Statement-II explains Statement-I.
- (b) Both Statement-I and Statement-II are correct, but Statement-II does not explain Statement-I.
- (c) Statement-I is correct, but Statement-II is incorrect.
- (d) Statement-I is incorrect, but Statement-II is correct.

2) Consider the following statements with reference to the IndiaAI Mission:

- 1. The mission aims to create a comprehensive ecosystem, drive AI innovation, and encourage AI use across sectors.
- 2. The implementing agency is Digital India Corporation (DIC).
- 3. The nodal ministry is the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.

Which one of the following conclusions based on the above statements is correct?

- (a) All three statements are correct.
- (b) There is no correct statement.
- (c) There are two correct statements that include statement 3.
- (d) There is only one correct statement.

3) Consider the following statements regarding the Kosi-Mechi River Linking Project:

- 1. The project is classified under the Himalayan Rivers Development Component of the National Perspective Plan.
- 2. It links the Kosi River with the Mechi River, a tributary of the Mahananda River.
- 3. It is overseen by the National Water Development Agency (NWDA) under the Union Ministry of Jal Shakti.

Which of the statements given above are correct?

- (a) 1 only
- (b) 1 and 2 only
- (c) 2 and 3 only
- (d) 1, 2 and 3

4) Consider the following with reference to the Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK):

PMJVK seeks to reduce socio-economic and infrastructure deficits in identified minority concentration areas through the creation of community assets and basic amenities.

Which of the following statements with reference to the above are correct?

- 1. The scheme is implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.
- 2. The scheme is implemented in areas having 50% or more minority population.
- 3. The scheme covers minority communities notified under the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992, and not the Constitution.
- 4. The infrastructure created under the scheme is meant for the use of all residents of the identified area and is not restricted exclusively to minority communities.



Select the answer using the code given below:

- (b) 1, 2, and 3 only
- (c) 2, 3, and 4 only
- (d) 1, 2, 3, and 4

5) Consider the following countries with reference to the international boundaries of Nigeria:

- 1. Niger
- 2. Cameroon
- 3. Benin
- 4. Ghana
- 5. Chad

Which of the above countries share a land boundary with Nigeria?

- (a) 1, 2, 3 and 5 only
- (b) 1, 2 and 4 only
- (c) 2, 3, 4 and 5 only
- (d) 1, 3, 4 and 5 only

Explanation

1) Answer: (C)

- **Statement-I is correct:** The PM SHRI (Pradhan Mantri Schools for Rising India) Scheme is a centrally sponsored scheme designed to upgrade and transform more than 14,500 existing schools across the country into model institutions that fully showcase the implementation of the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**.
- **Statement-II is incorrect:** Eligibility is not restricted *only* to Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs). Schools managed by the Central Government, State Governments, UT Administrations, and local bodies—including KVs, JNVs, and state-run government schools—are all eligible to apply and be selected under the scheme through a competitive "Challenge Mode."
- **Therefore, option C is the correct answer.**

2) Answer: (A)

- **Statement 1 is correct:** The IndiaAI Mission is designed to establish a comprehensive and inclusive AI ecosystem, democratize access to computing power (10,000+ GPUs), foster AI innovation, and drive adoption across various socio-economic sectors.
- **Statement 2 is correct:** The mission is being executed and implemented by the **IndiaAI Independent Business Division (IBD)** under the **Digital India Corporation (DIC)**.
- **Statement 3 is correct:** The **Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)** serves as the nodal ministry overseeing the mission.
- **Therefore, option A is the correct answer.**

3) Answer: (D)

- **Statement 1 is correct:** The project is classified under the Himalayan Rivers Development Component of India's National Perspective Plan (NPP) for river linking.



- **Statement 1 is Correct:** PMJVK is a **Centrally Sponsored Scheme** implemented by the **Ministry of Minority Affairs** to improve socio-economic infrastructure in identified minority concentration areas.
- **Statement 2 is Incorrect:** The scheme covers identified areas having **at least 25% minority population, not 50%**, along with socio-economic and infrastructure deficits.
- **Statement 2 is correct:** It involves linking the Kosi River with the Mechi River, which is a tributary of the Mahananda River.
- **Statement 3 is correct:** It is overseen by the National Water Development Agency (NWDA) under the Union Ministry of Jal Shakti.
- **Therefore, option D is the correct answer.**

4) Answer: (A)

- **Statement 3 is Correct:** The scheme covers **minority communities notified by the Central Government under the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992**. These communities are **not explicitly mentioned in the Constitution**.
- **Statement 4 is Correct:** PMJVK creates **community assets** such as schools, health centres, hostels and skill development centres. These assets are **open to all residents of the identified area** and are **not restricted exclusively to minority communities**, although the scheme primarily targets minority concentration areas.
- **Therefore, option A is the correct answer.**

5) Answer: (A)

- **Niger (1):** Shares Nigeria's northern border.
- **Cameroon (2):** Shares Nigeria's eastern border.
- **Benin (3):** Shares Nigeria's western border.
- **Chad (5):** Shares Nigeria's northeastern border (around Lake Chad).
- **Ghana (4)** does not share a land boundary with Nigeria, as the countries of **Togo** and **Benin** lie between them along the Gulf of Guinea coastline.
