- 1) Consider the following assertion:

The Delimitation Commission is an independent body constituted to redraw the boundaries of parliamentary and assembly constituencies in India.

Which of the following is/are the basis of the above assertion?

1. The Delimitation Commission is appointed by the President of India.
2. Its orders have the force of law and cannot be questioned before any court.
3. The Commission works on the basis of the Census figures for delimiting constituencies.

- 2) Consider the following statements:

Statement I: The Collegium System gives primacy to the judiciary in the appointment of judges to the Supreme Court and High Courts.

Statement II: The Second Judges Case (1993) held that the opinion of the Chief Justice of India, formed in consultation with senior judges, should have primacy in judicial appointments.

Statement III: The Third Judges Case (1998) clarified that the Chief Justice of India could make recommendations for judicial appointments without consulting the other senior judges of the Supreme Court.

Which one of the following is correct in respect of the above statements?

- (a) Both Statement II and Statement III are correct and both of them explain Statement I
- (b) Both Statement II and Statement III are correct but only one of them explains Statement I
- (c) Only one of the Statements II and III is correct and that explains Statement I
- (d) Neither Statement II nor Statement III is correct

- 3) Which of the following statements with regard to the Commonwealth Games is/are correct?

1. The Games are organised under the Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF).
2. The Commonwealth Games are held every four years.
3. Indoor bowls is introduced in the 2026 Games for both able-bodied and para athletes.

- 4) With reference to the National Urban Co-operative Finance and Development Corporation Limited (NUCFDC), consider the following statements:

1. It is registered as a Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC) with the Reserve Bank of India.



2. It functions as an umbrella organization for the entire Urban Co-operative Banking (UCB) sector in India.
3. It is vested with the statutory authority to regulate and supervise the individual member Urban Co-operative Banks.

How many of the statements given above is/are correct?

- (a) Only one
- (b) Only two
- (c) All three
- (d) None

- 5) The bilateral Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Exercise is conducted by the Indian Navy with the navy of which of the following countries?
- (a) France
 - (b) United States
 - (c) Japan
 - (d) Russia

Explanation

1) Answer: (D)

- **Statement 1 is correct:** The Delimitation Commission is a high-powered body appointed by the President of India and works in collaboration with the Election Commission of India.
- **Statement 2 is correct:** According to the statutory provisions of the Delimitation Act, the orders of the Delimitation Commission have the force of law and are final, meaning they cannot be questioned or challenged before any court of law.
- **Statement 3 is correct:** The primary mandate of the Commission is to redraw the boundaries of Lok Sabha and State Legislative Assembly constituencies based on the population data obtained from the latest Census.
- **Therefore, option D is the correct answer.**

2) Answer: (C)

- **Statement I is correct:** The Collegium System grants primacy to the judiciary (specifically the Chief Justice of India and a collegium of senior judges) in the appointment and transfer of judges to the Supreme Court and High Courts, minimizing executive discretion.
- **Statement II is correct:** The Second Judges Case (*Supreme Court Advocates-on-Record Association v. Union of India*, 1993) ruled that the opinion of the Chief Justice of India—formed in consultation with his senior colleagues—must be given primacy, effectively establishing the core of the Collegium System.
- **Statement III is incorrect:** The Third Judges Case (1998) clarified precisely the opposite of this statement; it held that the Chief Justice of India *cannot* make recommendations unilaterally. Instead, "consultation" requires a pluralistic approach involving a collegium consisting of the CJI and the **four senior-most** Supreme Court judges, and any recommendation made without complying with this collective consultation process is not binding.
- Therefore, only Statement II is correct, and it directly explains how Statement I came to be established.
- **Therefore, option C is the correct answer.**



3) Answer: (D)

- The Commonwealth Games are a quadrennial event scheduled to take place **every four years**. First held in 1930, the cycle has been consistently maintained except for disruptions during World War II. **Hence Statement 2 is correct.**
- The sporting programme, selection of hosts, and operational governance are executed under the direct supervision of the **Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)**. **Hence Statement 1 is correct.**
- The **2026 Games in Glasgow** have officially shifted away from traditional outdoor lawns to present a brand-new **indoor bowls format**. This dynamic event structure is fully integrated to include both **able-bodied and para athletes** inside the SEC Centre venue complex. **Hence Statement 3 is correct.**
- **Therefore , option D is the correct answer.**

4) Answer: (B)

- **Statements 1 & 2 are Correct:** NUCFDC is registered with the RBI as an NBFC and acts as the apex umbrella organization to provide financial and technological support to Urban Co-operative Banks (UCBs).
- **Statement 3 is Incorrect:** NUCFDC is a developmental and supportive entity, not a regulatory body. Regulation and supervision of UCBs remain with the RBI and the respective Registrar of Cooperative Societies.
- **Therefore, option B is the correct answer**

5) Answer: (B)

- The Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) Exercise is a specialized bilateral training engagement between the **Indian Navy and the United States Navy** aimed at enhancing interoperability and professional cooperation between their specialist diving and EOD teams.
- **Therefore, option B is the correct answer**
